MANADATORY & ENFORCEABLE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS, PARENTS & SUPPORTERS

The St Damians Junior Football Club fully supports the Codes of Conduct as introduced by the AFL, Football Victoria and the YJFL. In order to play football at St Damians you will need to strictly abide by the following codes.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Perhaps the most important people when it comes to abiding by codes of conducts are the parents and supporters, they are the ones who set the example that the children will follow therefore the St Damians JFC expect that parents and supporters will model good behaviour and abide by their code of conduct.

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation but do not force them.
- Teach that enjoyment is more than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are then to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires, and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let your family down and yourself if you do - & many such comments are actually illegal now.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play by the rules – the rules of your club and laws of the game.
- Never argue with an umpire or other official – without these people, you can't play football.
- Control your temper – verbal abuse of officials and sledging other players doesn't help you enjoy or win any games.
- Be a team player – It's a great game treat it that way.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated – fairly.
- Co-operate with your coaches, the umpires and teammates.
- Play for your own enjoyment & to improve your skills.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your coach, team-mates and family if you do - & many such comments are actually now illegal.

By registering our child with the St Damians JFC we agree to abide by these principles. We support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any players, parents or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct.

Reminder from the League

The League brings to your attention again some of the behaviour of Trainers, Runners and Coaches, outlined below, that is unacceptable to the efficient running of our games. You are asked again to remind all parents that this sort of behaviour is not to happen and that they need to be more in control of their actions and utterings. The problems include:

- Trainers talking back to Umpires when asked to leave the Ground.
- Team sheets not being provided to umpires at half time.
- Trainers and Runners running through the line of play. Frees will start being awarded for this sort of thing if it doesn't cease.
- Trainers and Runners talking to players while on the mark. This is unacceptable.
- Coaches Bibs are not being worn during games by some Coaches.
- Some Runners are staying on the ground for far too long. It should be 2 messages and then back to the bench. Many stay on the ground and coach. This is a particular problem in the Under 10 Age Group.
- Trainers just wandering around the ground following the play. Trainers should only be on the ground when necessary.
- Too many people on the bench area.
