2010 PLAYER MILESTONES

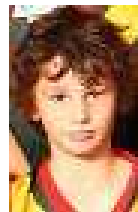
Sam James-100 Games-Under 15

Kyle Ziedaitis-100 Games-Under 15

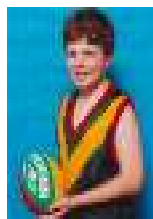
